Law Enforcement

Revision to 1.2.10 relating to duty to intervene. (LE1)- Language added for clarity. Revision to 4.1.6 relating to vascular neck restrictions. (LE1) – Standard is maintained as a conditional standard. Also training requirement is absorbed in a different standard.

Revision to 21.1.1 relating to job analyses. (OOOO)- Effort to formally change for uniformity across all four accreditation programs.

Revision to 22.1.3 (LE1) and 22.1.10 (MMMM) relating to bonding and liability.

Removal of duplicate language.

Revision to 33.4.1 (LE1) and 33.4.4 (LE1) relating to entry-level training. Cleared up duplicate language and moved commentary from the previous standard over. Revision to 33.4.4 (MMMM) (LE1) relating to entry-level training. Language added to commentary for clarity

Revision to 74.3.1 (MMMM) relating to criminal process procedures. Language added for clarity

 - The assessors had breakout rooms set up that they could jump in and out.
 The people that they needed to interview would just hop on when it is time for their interviews.
 - Communication and flexibility are keys to success with the virtual assessment platform.

 - Spring Conference Highlights:
 - 2,400 registered attendees
 - Virtual Training Sessions are available until 4/29/2021. If you want to receive a certificate of attendance and credit for the trainings, you need to watch the recordings by the 29th.
 - Lessons Learned:
 - Excessive wet ink
 - Unresolved Standards Issues (Time sensitive standards remain critical).
 - This may result in Conditions (Usually requires a file review within 1 year; severe cases may require a site-based

- assessment within 1 year; or report to review committee 1 year).
- <u>Don't Rush the Process:</u> This is especially important for initial accreditations.
- Critical incidents may result in an independent review by the commission including suspension of accredited status (happened to an agency in Mexico).
- Commissioner Marlon Lynch is in our region now. He is the Chief at Michigan State University.
- CALEA Policy Resource Library: https://www.powerdms.com/cprl/
 - 10 agency's are sharing access to their policies right now.
- Continuous Proofing is required by all agency's accredited after 1/1/2021 (Means you will maintain 4 years of proofs).
 - Dan Shaw is recommending that the proofs stay in the order that they were attached.
 - The recording on how to conduct the 4-year proofing process will be sent out to the PAC.
 - <u>Do not</u> go back and change old proofs. Just tell the assessors what you did back then.

Annual Status Report

- Make sure you your reports are detailed.
- o The new report was uploaded in February 21, 2021.

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• Web-based Assessments Process Changes

- CSM's will increase number of files reviewed by about 25% (100 -110 files)
- Results are reported in the Final Report!
- Make sure you fix those issues.
- Use videos of your own interviews
- Interviews will be conducted via chat (Zoom, Go To Meeting, etc.)
- Public information session will be via (Zoom, etc.)
 - If you can't conduct via (Zoom, etc.) It is recommended that you publicize well and extend the time of the call-in session.
- ALL assessments will be virtual through December 2021
- New Site-based assessment check-list will be available soon.
